Reading- Students began detective case files on their mystery books. They are looking for clues, suspects, and alibis.

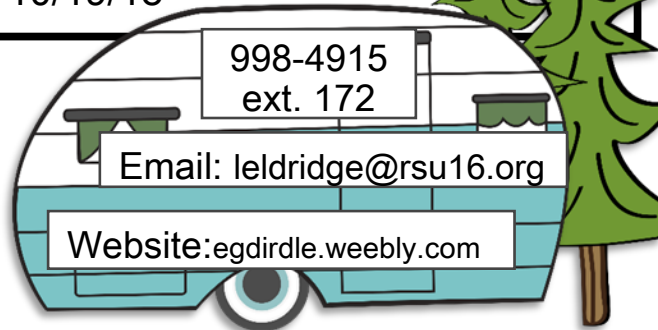
Spelling- We reviewed long vowels patterns and high frequency words this week and had our first spelling bee. Next week, we will work on short vowel patterns e and a.

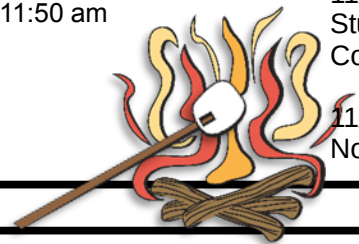

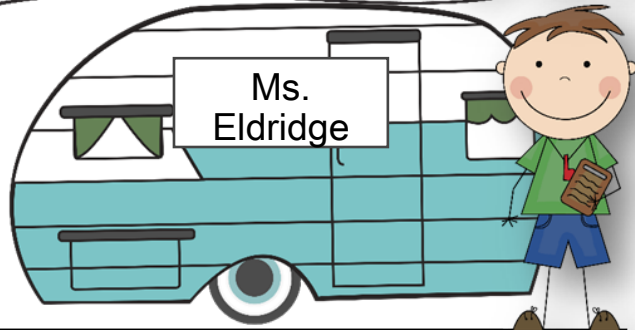

Scholastic Book Fair 11/2/18-11/8/18

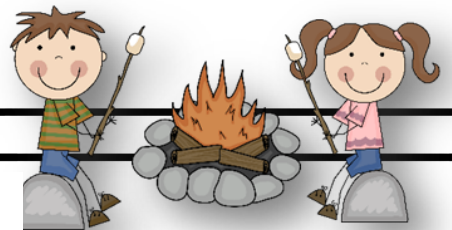
The Scholastic Book Fair is open 8:30 am-3:30 pm, except for 11/6 and 11/8 when it is open until 7 pm.
