Reading- Students are working on summarizing their mystery book chapters by detailing what happens at the beginning, middle, and end of their chapter.

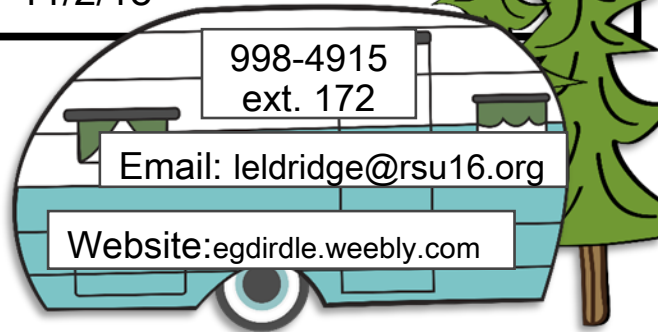
Spelling- Next week we will work on -er and -or sounds.

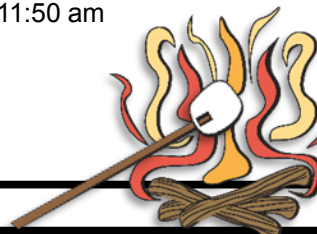

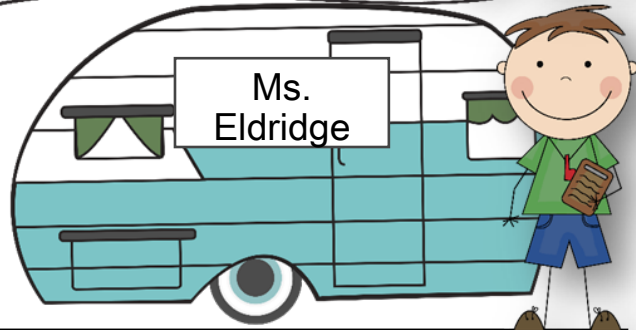

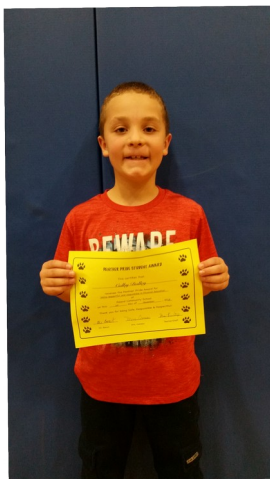

Scholastic Book Fair 11/2/18-11/8/18

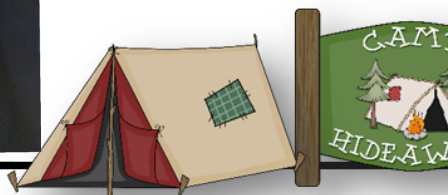
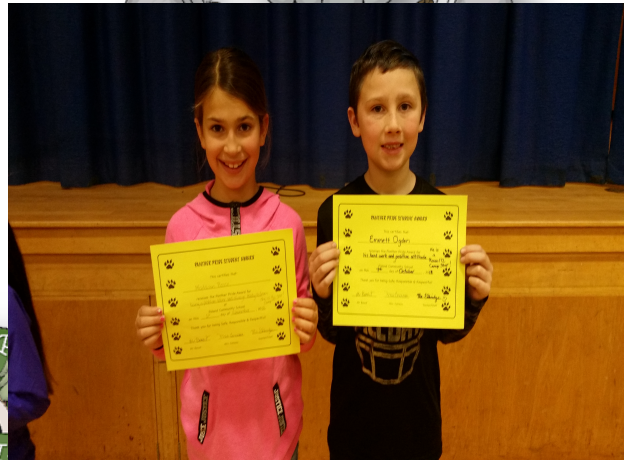
The Scholastic Book Fair is open 8:30 am-3:30 pm, except for 11/6 and 11/8 when it is open until 7 pm.
