Writing- Students worked on writing personal narratives about a special toy and small moments from their winter break.

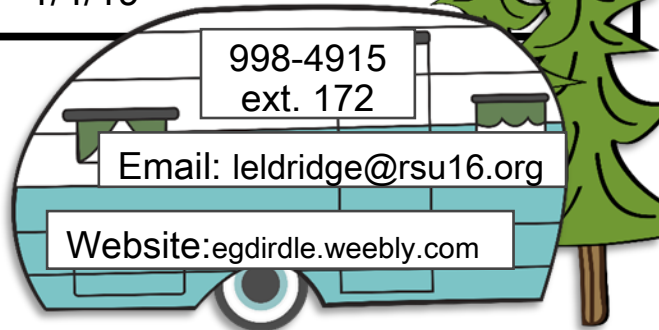

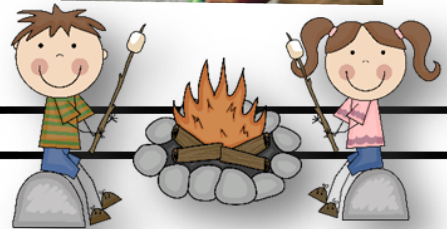
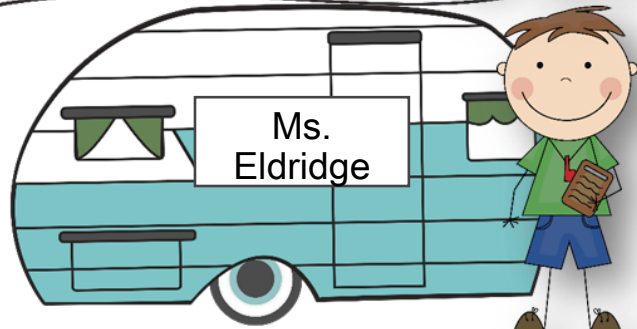
Narrative Writing Celebration
