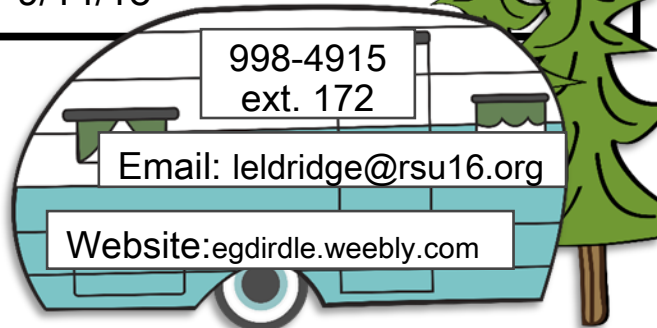
**Reading-** Students worked on close reading this week. Close reading requires students to read a passage more than once to find information. We also read a magazine article about the One World Trade Center building.

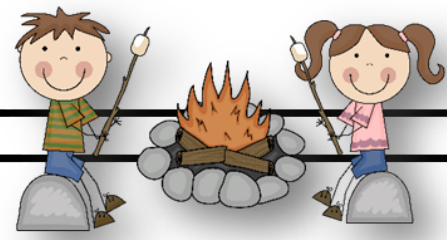
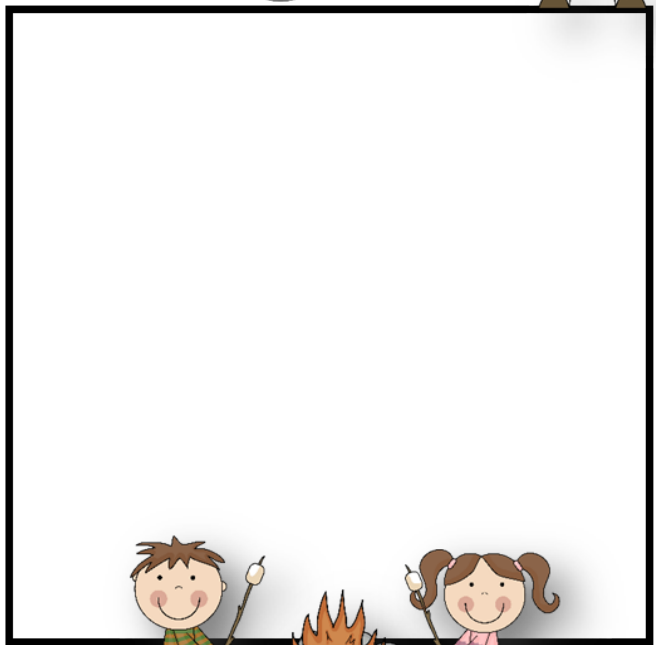
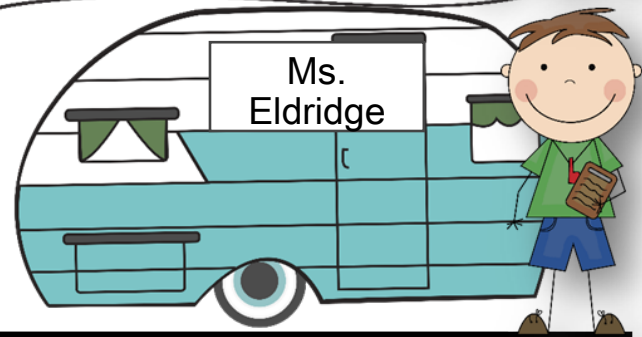
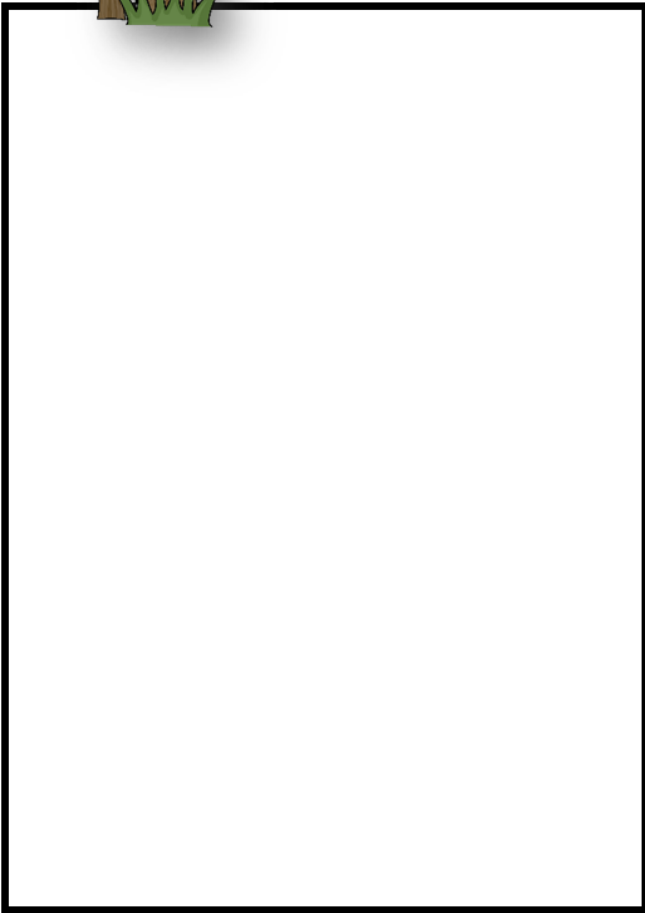
Students will either bring a bag lunch from school or home and eat at Ferry Beach. We apologize for the late notice, but we just found out the date of the field trip this week.
